Chung Yuan Christian University Department of Finance Academic Guidelines for Graduate Students

July/21st, 2021 Passed by the 3rd Academic Affairs Meeting, spring semester, Academic Year 2020-2021.

- Article 1 This Academic Guidelines of the department are formulated in accordance with the "CYCU Regulation Governing the Determination of Each Degree's Name, Conferral of Degrees, and Alternatives to Submission of a Master's Degree Thesis or Doctoral Dissertation".
- Article 2 The Chinese and English names for the Master's degrees awarded by this department are as follows:

- Article 3 Please refer to Appendix I for the Table of Curriculum & Credit for the Master.
- Article 4 Graduate students should achieve a total score of 750 in TOEIC or above to meet one of the graduation requirements.

For those who fail to meet the requirement, fulfill one of the following requirements to meet the graduation requirement: taking English courses or courses taught in English, or writing a thesis in English.

- Article 5 Graduate students must choose their thesis advising professors by the end of the first semester. If they don't, it will be decided by the Department Meeting.
- Article 6 Degree Examination Regulations
 - I. Thesis advising professor
 - A. Only full-time faculties at the assistant professor level or above in our department can be in charge of thesis advising professors.
 - B. If a co-supervisor is needed, graduate students can apply for it. However, they should receive approval from their thesis advising professors and notify the office of the Department of International Business. Afterward, they can find faculties at the assistant professor level or with doctoral degrees on campus or off campus as their co-supervisors.
 - C. The number of students in the same batch that each thesis advising professor help to form thesis cannot be more than 2. The number of students that professors in our department co-supervise with are regarded as 0.5 but not more than 2.

D. By the time Master's students apply for the "Oral Defense Examination," they will have to choose their thesis advising professors. If there is a special circumstance, students should submit relevant documents to the committee for review.

II. Thesis proposal

- A. The thesis proposal should be submitted five months before an oral defense examination.
- B. In principle, an oral defense examination will be held publicly. One of the oral exam committees is a thesis advising professor. In addition, a thesis advising professor should recommend more than two oral exam committees, one of whom should be out-of-the-department faculty at the assistant professor level or above.

III. Thesis

- A. Thesis shall be consistent with the expertise in our department. The following expertise is Finance, Accounting, Economy, Management, Financial Technology, etc. If there are any doubts, the chair will conduct a review meeting and invite thesis advising professors to explain. If it's certain that the thesis proposal is not consistent with the expertise in the department, graduate students shall edit it accordingly.
- B. A technical report can be an alternative to a thesis, whereas it is up to the committee.
- IV. The technical report should be consistent with the expertise in our department, and its rationales should be innovative. It should meet one of the following requirements:
 - A. The results of patent, technology transfer, or innovative research and development.
 - B. Projects with contributions on industry-academia cooperation or technology application, or the projects that provide benefits.
 - C. An organized and insightful written report with contributions on a case study on a professional technique or a discipline.
- Article 7 All other relevant matters not covered in these policies shall be governed by the "CYCU Academic Policies" and relevant regulations.
- Article 8 This guideline has been carried out in the review of the Academic Affairs Meeting. Any revision to this guideline will follow the same procedures.

 This regulation is applicable to Graduate students enrolled from the academic year

2021-2022.
